Conference Program

As usual the registration will be organized in the evening on Oct. 31 and in the morning on Nov.1 2003. The scientific reports will be held on Nov. 1 and in the morning on Nov.2, 2003. The GCPD's working report, board election and other issues will be done on Nov. 2, 2003. A concrete program will be distributed via e-mail early October 2003.

Submission of Abstracts and Papers

Every attendee should prepare a talk for 10 – 30 minute. An Abstract of your talk or of your paper should be written in English and limited one page (A4 size). The abstract will be published in the Technical Digest and is the basis for arranging the meeting program and sessions. The papers will be selected for publication in our official magazine "Journal of the Society of Chinese Physicists in Germany".

The papers from young Chinese scholars and students, who are first time to attend our annual conference, are especially welcome. The paper text with abstract should be written in a Word-document and sent to organization committee via e-mail. Arial type with 12 points is recommended for text and all page margins should keep 2.5 cm. Author name, affiliations and addresses should be given at the top under the article title. Please carefully proofread your material before sending it.

The abstract, together with the registration form filled, should be sent to Dr. Shi Renhu via email. The deadline for abstract and paper is **September 30, 2003**.
