Foreword

The annual conference of the Society of Chinese Physicists in Germany (GCPD) has been running since 1990 twelve times in Germany, bringing Chinese physicists and other scientists from related interdisciplinary areas in Germany together and providing them a major forum for the exchange of scientific ideas. It builds also a bridge for Chinese scientists in Germany to develop new ideas how to contribute more to China.

The 13th Annual Conference of the Society of Chinese Physicists in Germany (GCPD'02) will be held in Frankfurt am Main.

Technical Program

Because the technical programs have limited time on Oct. 27 from 8:00 to 14:00. The topics / reports should be limited in 15 minutes. The topics should represent the field of physics, physical engineering and related interdisciplinary areas as well as some special topics related to overseas Chinese scholars as a whole. The poster papers are welcome.

Submission of Abstracts and Summaries

Papers are welcome to submit from Chinese scholars in all academic and engineering disciplines related to physics, especially those reporting on most recent research and development results as well as the advanced technologies for present and future applications. Talking style in a popular science way is strongly encouraged. For the first time high-quality papers on research topics related to Chinese students in Germany or Chinese-German cooperation are also welcome to submit from Chinese scholars.

An **Abstract** of 30 words and a **Summary** of paper limited to 1 page A4 size (in English) are required. The **Abstract** will be published in the Advance Technical Program and the **Abstract & Summary** in the Technical Digest. Therefore, it is required to format the **Abstract & Summary** as the attached Sample.

We accept only electronic submission by sending your submission as an attached „WORD“ document via e-mail for better editing. List the title, author names, affiliations, and addresses at the top. First is the **Abstract** with text and then the **Summary**. All text should be written in Arial or a similar type. Use **13 point type** for the text; **15 point type** may be used for the title. The right and left margins should measure 2.5 cm each. Also the upper and down margins should measure 2.5 cm each too.

The deadline for submission of abstract and summary is **September 30, 2002**. Carefully proofread your material before sending it to: **Liu Jianping, Wang Hexing and Wu Ting** (address see below).

„The Best Thesis Award“

The GCPD will continue the „The Best Thesis Award“ during our meeting to promote young physicists and scientists in presenting their research work. Only one participant will be honored for her/his best presentation during our annual meeting, which will be selected by the GCPD's organizing committee among all those papers presented by the participants who give their talks or present their posters for the first time at our annual meeting.

The winner of „The Best Thesis Award“ will be honored with a certificate and a special gift in the value of 50 Euro for scientific purpose in a ceremony at the end of the meeting.
